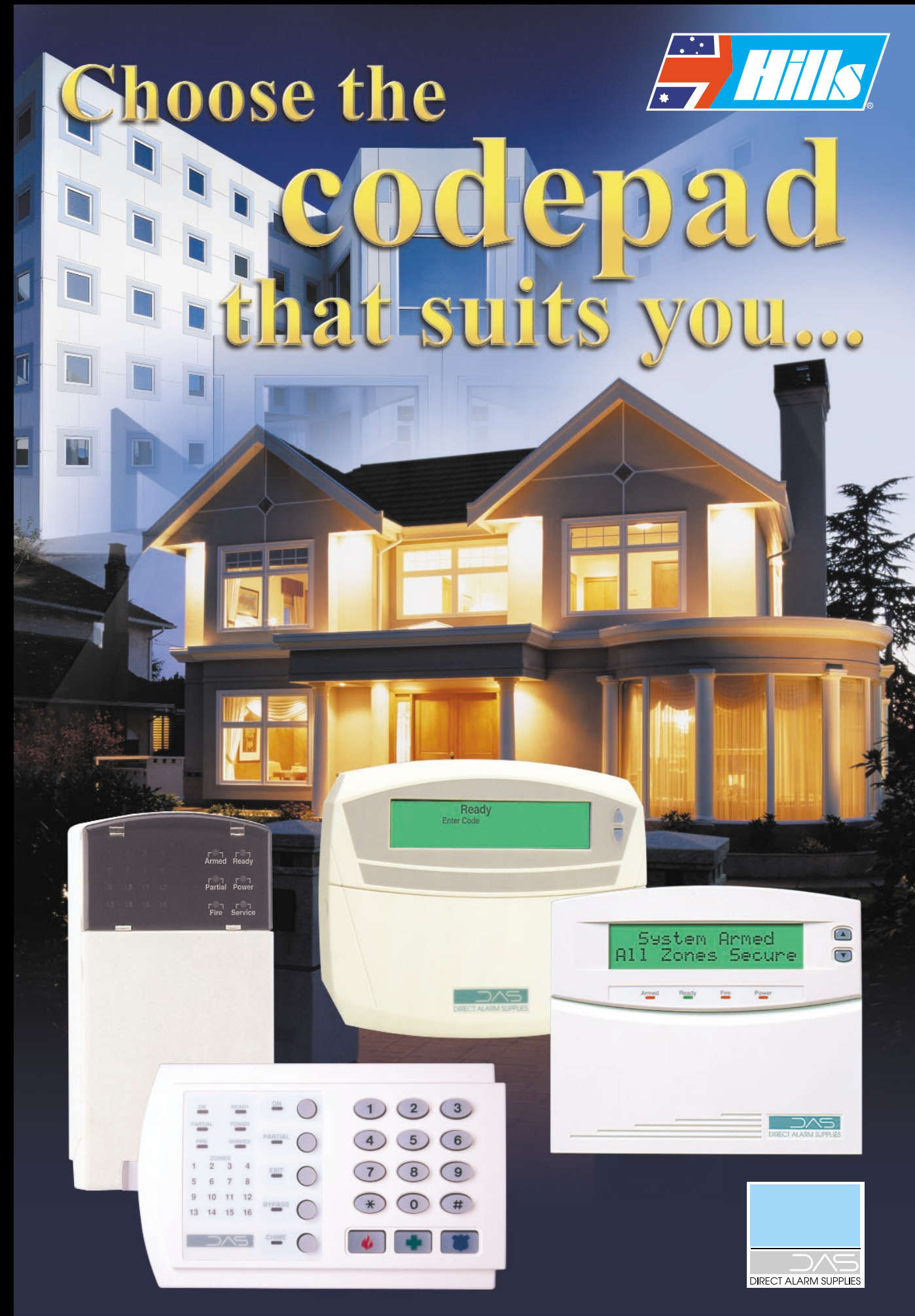

Simple to operate

FUNCTION KEYS:

Five specialised buttons perform the most common functions with one touch.

ON:

Turning your system on is as easy as pressing this button.

PARTIAL:

Press this button to arm your system & automatically bypass selected motion sensors to allow freedom of movement within your home or premises.

Home example: secure downstairs and stay upstairs.

Business example: secure warehouse or storeroom and stay in the office or shop.

EXIT:

This button extends your exit time during the exit delay when you need more time, but have already armed the system.

The exit time is selectable at installation.

BYPASS:

When arming the system, you may choose to bypass individual detection devices temporarily, allowing freedom of movement within certain areas, while the rest of the premises is protected.

Home example: a guest room in use.

Business example: an office in use on weekends or after hours.

CHIME:

This button turns the "Chime" feature on & off. When it is on, a pleasant ding-dong sound will let you know that an outer door or window has been opened.

Home example: a sliding door leading to a pool area.

Business example: shop front door.

EMERGENCY KEYS:

These can be programmed to contact fire, ambulance, or police personnel via a 24 hour control room if an emergency occurs. Just press and hold the button for 2 seconds.

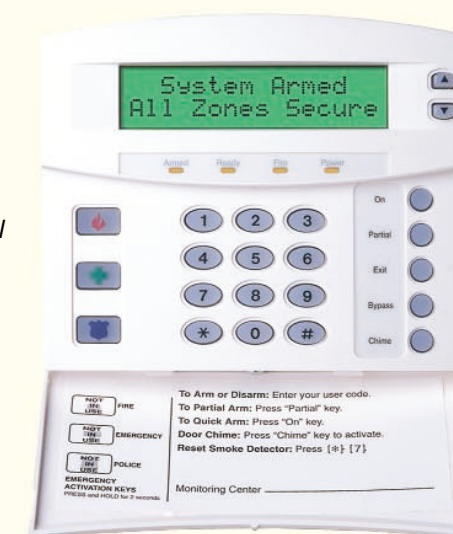


Liquid Crystal Display (LCD)

The NX LCD code pad is the ultimate choice - it gives you information about your security system status in plain english.

Easily identify which zone has been activated - you can even name them according to the areas they cover eg. "Warehouse PIR 1", or "Master Bedroom". The lid prevents accidental keypresses and is an ideal location for the zone description sticker.

The LCD offers control of 1 to 48 zones from the one code pad.



Fixed English

The Fixed English code pad sits between an LCD and LED - it has preset messages that are displayed.

Messages like "Armed", "Read", "Not Ready", "Alarm" and "Enter Code" prompt you for actions, and inform you of the security system status. Like the LCD, the flip lid hides the keys from accidental keypresses.

The Fixed English code pad offers control of 1 to 48 zones from the one code pad.

Standard LED

If you're looking for a modern design, with large buttons designed for easy use, you can't go past the NX LED.

The keys are easily accessible, and easy to read. The LED zone numbers flash when the zone is in alarm, and are constant when bypassed. The small slide-out panel provides the ideal location for your zone descriptions sticker.

The LED offers control of 1 to 24 zones from the one code pad.



Vertex

Not only is the VerteX easy to use, its also physically designed to comfortably fit in that small area between a door frame and a wall. The flip lid means you can hide the keys, so accidental key presses can be avoided. It also makes the code pad less obtrusive amongst your building decor. And it gives you the added convenience of a quick visual reference for the zone identification sticker, just in case you forget.

The VerteX offers control of 1 to 16 zones from the one code pad.
